## DRIVING AND PARKING SAFELY AROUND OUR SCHOOL

Many parents and teachers have talked to me about the unsafe practices of parents/carers while driving and parking around our school. These behaviours resulted in a minor accident occurring recently. We were very lucky that it was only a car that was damaged, as some of these behaviours are putting our children at risk. Some things to remember:

- 1) Only park in designated areas—DO NOT DOUBLE PARK. DO NOT PARK ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE ROAD.
- 2) Children should be getting out of the car on the footpath side.
- 3) DO NOT DROP YOUR CHILDREN OFF DIRECTLY OUT THE FRONT OF THE SCHOOL. THIS IS ILLEGAL BETWEEN 8AM AND 4PM AND YOU WILL RISK GETTING A FINE.
