when days are short,

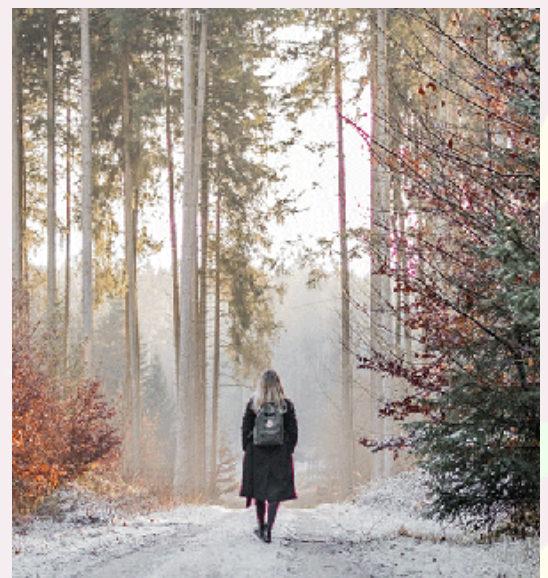
dawn comes late,

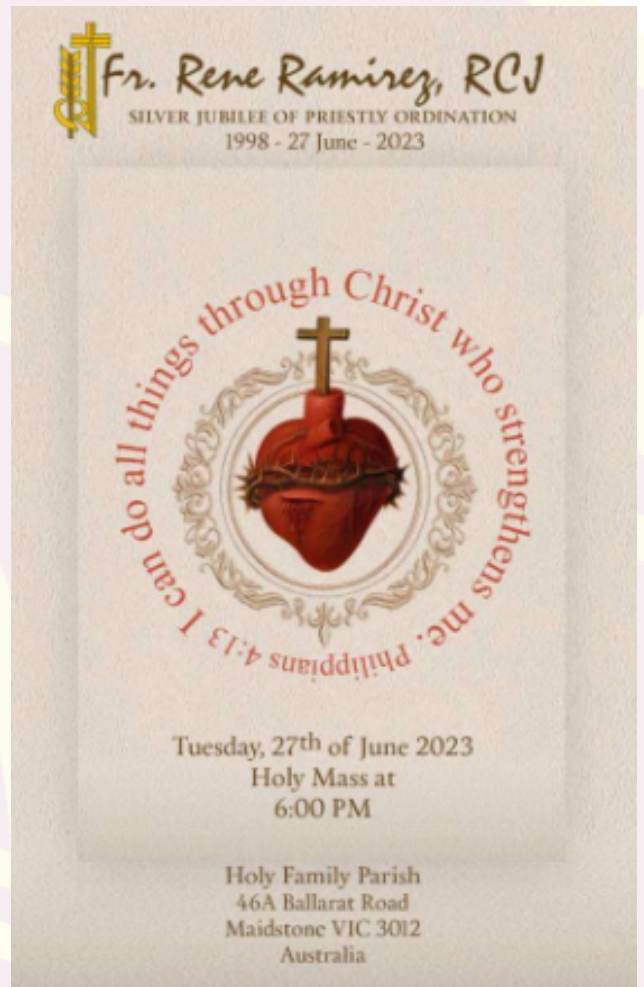
