Lent

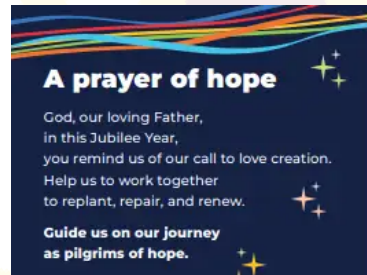
